

Reading Testers - Needed first four days of Summer Camp (June 5th, 9th, 10th, & 11th) and last four days of Summer Camp (July 16th, 17th, 21st, & 22nd). You will watch a training video explaining what a reading tester is. This is a new video that was recorded in February to be current and relevant for this year's programming.

All About Me - Do you have a fun passion/job that you want to share with the PT children. Once a week someone from the community comes and will talk with the PT children about what they do. It can be a fire fighter, police officer, doctor, lawyer, restaurant owner, librarian, someone who sews, Rancher, vet, the ideas are endless. We need just 4 peoples/ groups to come and speak to the PT children and show them what they do. If you or anyone you know would like to participate please contact the church office.
