

Pastor Musings

Thoughts and Advice from Pastor Joe, St. Mark UMC, September 2023 Believing What God Can Do

Jesus answered them, "Truly I tell you, if you have faith and do not doubt, not only will you do what has been done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' it will be done. Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will receive."

-Matthew 21:21-22

Confession: I do not like all Bible passages equally. That does not take away from my faith in the Bible as the written word of God. It is simply an acknowledgement that I like some biblical stories more than others. The passage above, where Jesus declares that those who "have faith and do not doubt" can move mountains, is one that I don't like as much as others. I have seen these words get abused to enable ministries with large media budgets to shame and bully their followers into doing unhealthy things. Further, I have never actually seen anyone literally move a mountain on command, so that makes me like this passage even less.

Yet if I sit with this passage, I can see what Jesus is truly saying. For starters, Jesus says that "Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will receive." "With faith"—that faith in the one who died and rose from the dead, that faith that equips us to "take up [our] cross and follow [Jesus]" (Matthew 16:24). Faith is not just our willingness to conjure up Jesus' name when we want to do something miraculous, but truly having faith to go wherever Jesus leads us. When we do that, we recognize that God is, indeed, capable of doing so much more through us than we can possibly do on our own. Whatever challenges, obstacles, or dilemmas you face, truly put your faith in the will and The Way of Jesus Christ, who is with us always by the power of the Holy Spirit, and through whom we can indeed do all things that we ask for in faith.
