Pastor Musings

Thoughts and Advice from Pastor Joe, St. Mark UMC, June 2025 Numbers

"And [Peter] testified with many other arguments & exhorted them, saying, 'Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.' So those who welcomed his message were baptized, & that day about 3,000 persons were added. They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching & fellowship, to the breaking of bread & the prayers."—Acts 2:40-42, NRSV

Those who've been to St. Mark Board meetings know that I like numbers. On a weekly basis, I pay attention to the number of worshippers and small group participants we've had. On a monthly basis, I await the numbers related to church finances, food pantry recipients, Communion Rail offering, and Preschool enrollment. This summer, I'm tracking Project Transformation enrollment and volunteer signups. Our own newsletter includes worship, small group, and giving numbers from the prior month. I even keep track of related annual metrics for the congregations in our regional conference, as time allows!

Certain sections of the Bible also care about numbers. The Bible even has the Book of Numbers, which begins and ends with a census of the Israelites in the desert. The first several chapters of Acts also share numbers of new converts who were responding to the gospel message of salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ. Jesus even tells us that our heavenly Father makes sure that "all the hairs of your head are counted" (Luke 12:7).

Do you ever numerically keep track of your faith journey and commitments? How many times do you attend public worship (at St. Mark or elsewhere) each month? Bible studies? How many hours do you volunteer for St. Mark or other faith or community focused service opportunities each month? How much time do you read the Bible on your own each week? How much do you contribute financially to the church and charities that serve those in need—and how much of your income does that encompass? I do not mean to add this as a burden to anyone—I'm not requiring this as homework or anything! But if you're a numbers person like me, I'd encourage you to keep track--& see how the Lord empowers your faith commitments to increase!
